Staff Job Descriptions - Summer Camp Mentor (Rainbows)

Sunrise Community Farm Center is searching for passionate youth leaders to lead summer camp activities! Rainbow mentors will work with our Rainbow campers. These campers are rising kindergarteners to rising third graders, ages 5-8. If you are passionate about helping our youngest campers thrive in an outdoor farm setting, we would love to meet you. Camp programs include gardening, arts and crafts, animal care, horse riding, and more!

Rainbow Mentors work with and supervise an Assistant Mentor to lead a group of 10-12 kids through camp activities. Mentors need to be flexible, open to growth and learning opportunities, and have clear communication with the Assistant Mentors they work with. Job takes place entirely outside, so Mentors need to be ready to perform physical tasks and not afraid to get dirty! This position is about 35 hours per week. It is preferred that a Rainbow Mentor has either previously worked as an Assistant Mentor, or as a Junior Mentor in our programs in the past, or at another summer camp program in a similar capacity. Must be available the majority of the summer.

Responsibilities:

- Lead Assistant Mentors with daily fun activities and guidance of Rainbow Campers
- Understand and plan ahead for the schedule following the rainbow activities guidance from Program Director
- Act as an example to other Assistant Mentors in professionalism by arriving on time, presenting kindness and maturity, and demonstrating problem solving skills in the face of crisis.
- Understand and organize daily Rainbow Activities with assistance from supervisor
- May offer enrichment classes and electives as supported by personal interests
- Coach assistant and junior mentors on engaging directly with campers, how to care for camper health, and in steps toward fulfilling the Children's Camp and Activity Goals listed in the Staff Manual.
- Maintain a positive attitude through potential camper challenges
- Respond well to constructive criticism and feedback
- Facilitate safe positive interactions between campers and farm animals
- Help support the emotional and physical safety of all campers via instruction from Mentors.
- Lead Mentors must be 17 years of age with prior experience, or 18 years of age to apply.
